## ANNUAL GENERAL AND SPECIAL MEETING OF UNITHOLDERS NOTICE AND ACCESS NOTIFICATION TO UNITHOLDERS

You are receiving this notification as Alaris Equity Partners Income Trust ("Alaris") has decided to use the notice and access model for delivery of meeting materials to its registered unitholders ("Registered Unitholders") and beneficial unitholders ("Beneficial Unitholders" and, together with the Registered Unitholders, "Unitholders"). Under notice and access, Unitholders will receive a form of proxy or voting instruction form enabling them to vote at the annual general and special meeting of Unitholders on May 7, 2026 (the "Meeting"). However, instead of paper copies of the management information circular of Alaris dated March 18, 2026 (the "Information Circular"), and Alaris' financial statements and related management's discussion and analysis for its most recently completed financial year end (collectively, the "Financial Information"), Unitholders receive this notification with information on how they may access the Information Circular and Financial Information electronically. The use of this alternative means of delivery is more environmentally friendly as it will help reduce paper use and will reduce the cost of printing and mailing materials to the unitholders of Alaris.

### UNITHOLDERS WILL BE ASKED TO CONSIDER AND VOTE ON THE FOLLOWING MATTERS AT THE MEETING:

**Fixing the Number of Trustees:** Unitholders will be asked to fix the number of trustees to be elected at the Meeting at six (6). You can find information respecting fixing of the number of trustees in the Information Circular under "*Business of the Meeting—2. Fixing Number of Trustees*".

**Election of Trustees:** Unitholders will be asked to elect Peter Grosskopf, Stephen W. King, Sophia Langlois, Kim Lynch Proctor, Felix-Etienne Lebel, and Sarah Hughes as trustees of Alaris for the ensuing year. You can find information respecting the election of trustees in the Information Circular under "*Business of the Meeting—3. Election of Trustees*".

**Approval of Unallocated RTUs:** Unitholders will be asked to consider and, if thought appropriate, to pass an ordinary resolution approving the unallocated Restricted Trust Units and the issuance of the underlying trust units pursuant to Alaris' Restricted Trust Unit Plan, as more particularly described in the Information Circular. You can find information respecting the unallocated RTUs in the Information Circular under "*Business of the Meeting—4. Approval of the Unallocated RTUs pursuant to the RTU Plan*".

**Approval of RTU Plan Amendments:** Unitholders will be asked to consider and, if thought appropriate, to pass an ordinary resolution approving certain amendments to Alaris' Restricted Trust Unit Plan, as more particularly described in the Information Circular. You can find information respecting the RTU Plan Amendment in the Information Circular under "*Business of the Meeting—5. Approval of the RTU Plan Amendment*".

**Approval of the Treasury Portion of the TCRP Plan:** Unitholders will be asked to consider and, if thought appropriate, to pass an ordinary resolution approving the treasury portion of Alaris' Total Common Return Participation Plan (TCRP Plan) and approving all unallocated Trust Units issuable thereunder, as more particularly described in the Information Circular. **Appointment of Auditors:** Unitholders will be asked to appoint KPMG LLP as Alaris' auditors for the ensuing year and authorize Alaris' trustees to fix the auditor's remuneration.
